



For this design, our vision was to create a space that was soothing and sophisticated - something we always like to incorporate into a master bedroom. We focused on mixing both modern and vintage-like pieces to give the room dimension and a "lived-in" feeling to make it as inviting as possible. This finished look is a space that both men and women would find themselves drawn to and can stand the test of time.

## • Wallpaper (Gray)

o We love the playfulness of the hand block pattern in this wallpaper but the color palette is sophisticated and softer which gives it a perfect romantic feel for bedroom.

## • Bed

o We like to mix wood and upholstery, you get the best of both words! Beds or headboards that feature a bit of upholstery add another level of comfort as well.

## • Nightstands

o These nightstands have a great storage element but the craftsmanship on them is articulate and make them feel like a custom piece.

# • <u>Lamp</u> (For Nightstands)

o These lamps add a little modern touch but the shape is what brings the impact. It's a subtle statement piece since it's done in a neutral color as well.

# • Artwork

o Adding a vintage element to any space has kind of become our signature at Bria Hammel Interiors. This artwork is a great piece to incorporate that antique feel.

# • Light Fixture

o We selected a light fixture in bronze for a bit of contrast. We always like incorporating fixtures that are also a bit oversized in nature - they add such a statement to a space!

## • Bedding (Duvet, Quilt)

o We often opt for bedding that feels tailored and clean but has a fresh twist. Here, the blue thought the quilt makes it feel layered and adds a pop of color instead of going with an all white bedding option.

## • Bed Pillows (Camel, Beige)

o To balance out some of the coolness in the bed and bedding, we selected camel and beige pillows for a pop of warmth.

#### • Pillow for Chaise

o For us, this pillow was the perfect balance of preppy and organic - which is unique since these two things are not often paired together!

## • Rug

o We went with a vintage style rug to ground the entire space. We like the coloring is not too powerful so the room remains simple and calming.

# • Side table

o A whimsical side table that mixes masculine and feminine - our favorite! The lines of this piece are more feminine but the finish gives it a masculine touch.

## • Chaise

o To avoid making the space feel crowded or busy, we selected a clean and tailored chaise lounge in a neutral tone to give the space a breather.

# • Lamp

o This floor lamp is fun because it has both modern and traditional details. Its scales out nicely and mixing white with bronze was a good nod to the chandelier finish.

#### • Chest

o The reeded front detail of this dresser complimented the nightstands we selected but weren't too matchy-matchy.

## • Mirror

o This mirror is one of our all-time favorites. It's whimsical while still being classic and in this finish it adds some warmth to the space.

- Lamp (For Chest)
  - o We are all about adding pops of texture to rooms to give it a more layered, lived-in look. This lamp was the perfect way to incorporate that!
- Nightstand accessories
  - o White Colorblock Vase We love this neutral vase that you can pop a fresh bouquet of greenery or flowers into. It's a nice, low height which makes it perfect for a nightstand.
  - o <u>Box</u> This is the perfect little box to throw your phone into while you're sleeping, your watch, or other little knick knacks to keep the top of our nightstand de-cluttered.
  - o <u>Tray</u> Another piece that gives a little bit of a vintage vibe. Not only is this piece beautiful, but its functional in the sense that you can use it as a catch-all tray.
  - o <u>Blue and White Jar</u> Will a blue and white jar ever go out of style? We think not! This piece is a no-brainer and a simple little addition to any space.
  - o <u>Candle</u> The finishing touch for any room but especially a bedroom! A soft, luxurious scent makes the bedroom an even more relaxing space.
- Chest accessories
  - o Coffee table books (one, two) these are styling must-have. We love adding a stack of books to a chest or dresser to "ground" other accessories that sit on top of them.
  - o <u>Footed Plate</u> We love the subtle modern flair this footed plate brings to the space. It compliments the other modern touches throughout the space but does it in a neutral, classic way.
  - o Beads For a pop of color, we placed a set of beads inside of the footed plate.
  - o <u>Gold Leaf Statue</u> one of our favorite accessories to add to any space. It's such a statement decorative object we love the subtle, glamorous vibe it brings.
