Historic Market Square is a former furniture factory that has been transformed into unique upscale showrooms. The building features five floors with an incredible backdrop of original hardwood floors, exposed brick, massive wood columns and other original features of this repurposed factory complex, which is North Carolina's largest adaptive-use building listed on the National Register of Historic Places.

Market Square has been a mainstay of the High Point Market for more than 25 years and is a key destination for retailers and designers in search of finer goods in all categories from furniture, to rugs, wall art, lighting, textiles, softgoods and decorative accessories. Buyers in Market Square range from top 100 retailers, to high-end specialty retailers, and designers and architects.

The building is conveniently located just a short walk from the transportation terminal or is accessible by market transportation.

SERVICES AND AMENITIES:

Market Square is home to "The Factory Restaurant, the only full service restaurant and bar in downtown High Point and the String & Splinter Club, which is great for entertaining customers during or between markets. The Market Square Courtyard hosts a range of events during market including such past events as fashion shows, live entertainment, Octoberfest, top designer book signings, celebrity designer meet-n-greets, among others.

OPEN YEAR-ROUND TO THE TRADE:
